At every plant, a specific plant employee provided the detailed understanding about their work to the students.

Most of the machines in plant are semiautomated and some are manually operated.

After visiting all the plants, the students talked with Mahesh Vashi sir. Some of the students had some plant related or some other general questions. Each and every question was satisfactorily answered by Maheshbhai.

Total manpower in this Vilayat plant is around 900. Out of them 300 are operational workers. Future expansion is in the offing. So the target is to increase the man power by around 2000 to 3000 in all.

Some other detailed information about the company like their competitors, suppliers of some raw materials etc. was also shared.

Sh. Mahesh Vashi sir and his entire team imparted the best practical knowledge about their work. It was really a great opportunity to get to visit such a reputed company.






